EXCERPTS OF THE INTERVIEW WITH THE DIRECTOR

Q. What are your earliest memories of your childhood?

Director (smiles): I lost my father very early in life when I was just 8 years old. I remember him very vaguely. But one fond memory is that he would ask me to recite Telugu poems. I remember him feeling very happy and proud.

Q. That's so sweet sir. Do you have any regrets in connection to your early life?

Q. Ok, but you have had a successful career. As an administrator, did you face any challenges in the initial years?

Q. What is the vision you have for the college?

Director (optimistic): In 5 years' time, Aditya must be the most preferred college by students. We want to reach that level where it becomes the first option for admissions.

Q. When you recruit faculty, what are the three things that you are searching for?

Director: I am not very particular about qualification or percentage. For me, the attitude of the person is important. The person should be dedicated towards the college and must be work minded. Knowledge and problem solving ability is definitely an added advantage.

Q. What are the things that aspiring entrepreneurs need to remember?

Director: According to me, keep it simple. We should have achievable targets to accomplish. The business should be in accordance with the requirements of the target group of customers. One must have the knowledge and conviction that whatever one is doing will be a success.

Q. That's nice Sir. OK, What makes you really happy as a person?

Director(smiles): Little things bring pleasure to me. A small event that is well executed or a staff interaction that has gone well or a small event that was well organized or a good intellectual talk, or a glimpse of an Aditya Alumnus doing well in life-it could be anything. Personally, my kids' achievements in their academics makes me very happy and proud. Also, the positive feedback of my other ventures like convention centre and school is extremely satisfying.

Q. Can you name any cherished moments at Aditya?

Director: There are many. But one of the most cherished moments has been the year 2010(second year of our college inception) when all the seats in our college got filled up. We realized that we were getting recognition for our efforts in the town. In addition, we have been getting gold medals consistently. Other things like Conferment of NAAC A+ is one of the cherished moments.

Q. Do you have any dream project?

Director (optimistic): My dream project is to develop a senior citizens villa community

Q. And how do you recognize an opportunity?

Director: Probably, I am perceptive, or I have a sixth sense or I have a quick thinking mind. I don't know but I have the ability to recognize an opportunity and I make sure to utilize it.

Q. What has been your major learnings in life?

Director: My major learnings from life have been to seize every opportunity that presents itself, no matter how small.

Q. Do you believe that time plays a crucial role in life, that is right thing should be done at the right time or do you feel that one can do anything at any age.

Director: I think, time is very crucial. We must do the right thing at the right age. We may not have the same enthusiasm if we let the moment pass.

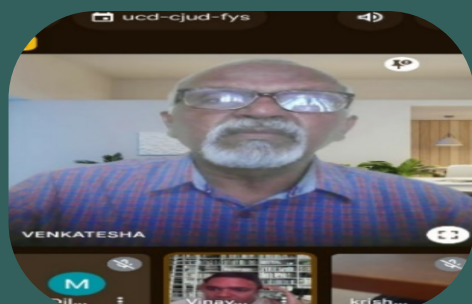

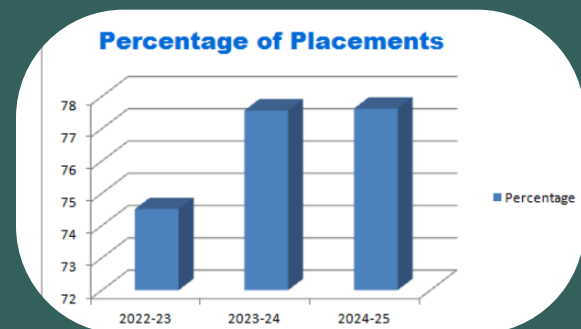

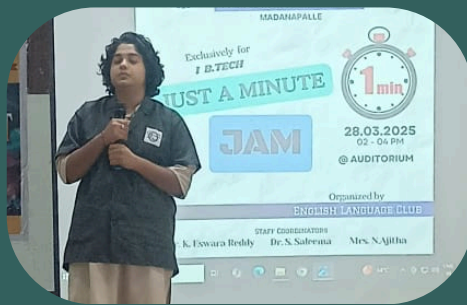

- Organized Awareness Program on "Industry- Internships" in April '25. The Principal spoke about the importance of short term internships to improve technical skills.



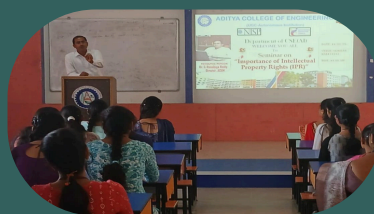

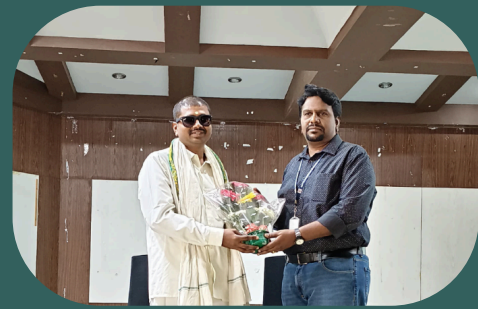

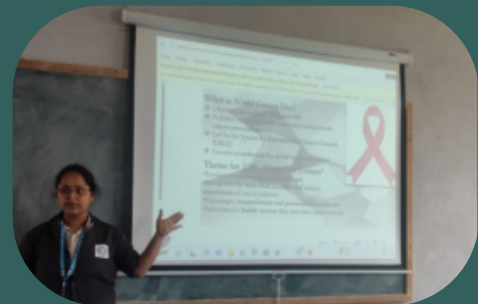
